    - UM Survive the Ride Team – special guest speaker
    - Florida has one of the highest motorcycle fatalities in the nation

  - AAA Safer Together postponed until November/December
  - Key West Rodeo on Saturday
- Special Presentation - Pedestrian and Bicycle Crash Statistics -  
The team was focused on the presentation, and Ms. Coleman requested a copy of the report.
    - Question about near miss data and collaboration with Safe Streets grant
    - Micromobility question? New state law? Can be added to scope. Use is high in Key West
  - Key West Update:
    - Mr. Atkinson talked about the Safe Streets Grant – AI tools and underground improvements have been awarded. Applying for a third grant. Signal upgrades/roundabouts. Bike Rodeo on Saturday. More planning, zoning in the future. SS4A still managing grant. Another grant for Key West bus shelters (north and west of City Hall) – will know this month. More bike racks.
    - Marianne - Bus shelter projects upcoming in the county? Transit budget cuts. Many people commute from Homestead/Florida City.
    - Ivonna – Alisa Islamorada – Janelle left position. County position.
    - Ray SS4A grant in Islamorada – have been awarded, being reviewed and signed off on. Three jurisdictions to have safety action plans.
    - SS4A - Not one in the county as far as Ray knows. Marathon regional task force – all jurisdictions to work together.
    - Ivonna – bike/ped safety in schools, provided presentations at middle schools, outreach events with police department 500 bike helmets fitted. Shared with as many lower key residents as possible for Saturday rodeo in Key West. 11 vendors have confirmed.

- Marianne – Leadership event - good turnout, not great. Parking and signage may be an issue. Debrief pending.
- **May 29 last day** of school year. **Summer school first week of June ends July** – limited this year. All up and down – one in upper, middle and lower keys. Summer camps? Churches and other programs have summer camps. Marine lab, research centers, throughout Monroe County.
- FIU/high school programs – looking for additional opportunities. National Night out in three different locations – August 2026 (last year August 5)
- Fire Department – cool day for kids (smaller events with water, ice cones) Layton
- CFK has a program – camps for kids (different ages) Beat the Heat, fire prevention heat,
