- Legislative update – Senate bill 382 – Governor vetoed bill [CS/SB 382](#)
The Governor has a vetoed bill. Micromobility device enforcement still can be handled by municipalities.
 - Difficult to maneuver
 - Enforcement difficult to manage
 - Reservations about task force sunset date

MDCPS Updates:

Traffic safety: Staff retiring, preparing for the upcoming school year. Principals are going through training. Traffic safety due to micromobility is becoming more of a focus. Continue working with the UM Walk Safe team. Proposal to continue safety presentations. AAA reached out for safety patrols. September bi-monthly CTST meetings. August 13 school year begins. More school bus drivers have applied.

Transit hubs: Met with Doral, Town of Miami Lakes and Homestead. How can we maximize efficiency by using trolley service – drop off close to schools? Also working on agreements with county – cannot duplicate existing bus routes. Parents have choices in school locations, making commutes more complicated.

Charter School Students: Beneficial for students to be engaged with CTST. Discussions evolving into having an CTST team just for Charter Schools or for them to be included in this one.

TPO Updates:

Safe Routes to Schools construction plans – this year complete. Working on next year's plans. Waiting for a FDOT response regarding Tallahassee contact. Will need MDCPS plans for this meeting. Fabian – new staff contact for SRS.

Upcoming events: Coordinating with City of Hialeah and SFRTA start strategizing for Rail Safety Week in September. Parking days are in September. Last week – Let's Take the Bus in West Miami with Transit Alliance and Vision Zero consultants. Next week – South Miami – public meeting for bike lanes on 64 street to Ludlam Trail. In two weeks, the Orlando Bike/Ped Safety Coalition meeting will be held. Requested Bike/Ped Rodeo in Miami Lakes in September?

November Miami Lakes K-8 Center – students ride bikes to school. Revisit ideas but challenging to hold in September (perhaps end of month). Media release forms take time. November is the end of hurricane season – better conditions.

Walk to school day is October 7 at Palmetto Elementary in Pinecrest. Palmetto Senior band group performs. Invites/reminders coming in August.

Vision Zero updates:

- Miami Lakes - August Vision Zero – once posted, will be visible on map.
- West Miami – pilot project
- Homestead – just started
- Supplemental planning funding – Opa-locka, Miami Lakes
- Village of Biscayne Park – TPO part of safety task force – date pending
- Miccosukee pending
- Hialeah – a big recipient of \$1.5 million funding, beginning August and September – one of the most crashes in Miami-Dade County.



DTPW Vision Zero Updates:

SS4A grants all three elements - implementation, supplemental planning and xx. Working with UM on research tasks. Cambridge Modal – collect data track driver behavior (provided by insurance companies). Management is changing at the federal level at the beginning of the school year.

- East 4 avenue improvements in Hialeah – design finalized June of next year.
- Bike/ped feasibility study – SW 160 Ave., part of MDCPS for right of way. MDCPS contact provided contact info for discussions.

FDOT Request: Next steps for cities – how does the flow look? Discussion on process/outline to be held offline. Depending on location. DTPW looks at city roads but prioritizes county roads. Overtown, Miami Beach and Hialeah projects update may be provided in December. For county roads, coordination with city during design process.

Equitable Development Programs – equitable distribution program – procurement vehicle/tool.

Road safety audits are starting soon – the majority in the northern part of the county. 5 or 6 audits coming soon. Bicycle fatality reduction passports – also has videos for AI assistance. Video Safety Analysis. Collected videos, AI coding begins to see what types of near misses are happening. More proactive approach – provide counter measures to prevent crashes. Commissioner Rosado – beginning roadway safety audit. He requested to be updated as progress develops.

Reviewing consultants to do the audits. Coordinate safety action plans already in place (or proposed). Example – Opa-locka – big issue is mid-block crossings (near bus stops). 25 percent of accidents are related to traffic. Coordinate with cities – high incident locations – bigger leverage from FDOT for roadway improvements.

Example – Miami Lakes 57 Avenue (state road)

Hialeah – city roads

Align audits with state efforts, move forward together. Forwarded contact with FDOT construction.

Walk Safe Bike Safe Updates:

UM July 31 bike rodeo South Miami – Bike Trailor

Bike Rodeo – Falls Lifetime Gym – date pending (August)

Vision Zero – trauma data. More than just bikes/peds. Now it includes e-scooters. Nicklaus started collecting in 2023.

Looking at medical records – age, range, time of injury type/accidents (not Hippa info). Jackson Ryder Trauma (not easily identified – filtered)

Looking for shifts/trends in data.

Multi-category – device (6 categories – ped, bikes, e-bikes e-scooter and standing electric – hover boards, others standard scooters, skates - hit by cars)

Jackson South – trauma cases (because of location is nearby)

Monroe County – Federal Highway Administration – Elizabeth and Natalia may join. Ivonna is working on helping Jackson South with safety events.

Elizabeth to go first during the next CTST meeting TPO – invite us to everything!
